Notice of Race

1.0 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* 2021-2024 and class rules of 3.7 and J14 Owners Associations.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 The Racing Rules will be changed in accordance with rule 86 as follows:

 For protests where only a Rule of Part 2 or rule 31 is alleged to have been broken an Arbitration Hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.
- 1.4 Changes to Class Rules: None

2.0 Advertising

The Organising Authority may require all participating boats to display the event sponsor's advertising in accordance with ISAF, Regulation 20.3 (d) (i).

3.0 Eligibility and Entry

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the 3.7 and J14 Classes that comply with the class rules **and sailors of all ages.**

- 3.2 Full entries will be accepted on July 24 2021 up until 1000hrs. Entry fee is \$60.00 Sunday only entries will be accepted on July 25 up until 1100hrs. Entry fee is \$30.00
- To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority.
- 3.4 All boats may be measured for compliance with the Class Rules.

4.0 Format of Racing

4.1 a total of 6 races, with a maximum of 3 races in a given day.

5.0 Schedule of Events

5.3 Briefing:

Briefing will take place on Saturday 24 July at 9.30am at WYC and Sunday 25 July at 10.15am.

5.4 Racing Schedule:

The scheduled time of the warning signal for Race 1 will be no earlier than 10.15 am Saturday 24 July.

No race shall start after 1320 hours on Sunday 25 July.

6.0 Sailing Instructions

6.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available on completion of registration

7.0 Racing Area

7.1 The races will be held on the waters off the Waiuku Yacht Club.

8.0 Courses to be Sailed

The course will be a windward/leeward course with a mark 1 offset and mark 2 gate, or a triangle and windward/leeward course. Courses will be determined by the OOD on the morning of racing to best suit conditions.

9.0 Scoring

- 9.2 2 races will be required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.3 When fewer than 4 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 9.4 If 6 races are completed a boat's worst race score will be discarded

10.0 Alternative Penalties

Appendix P may apply.

11.0 Prizes

The following prizes will be awarded to: 1st, 2nd and 3rd places.
