Notice of Race

1.0 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* 2021-2024 and the International Finn Class Rules 2011.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 The Racing Rules will be changed in accordance with rule 86 as follows: For protests where only a Rule of Part 2 or rule 31 is alleged to have been broken an Arbitration Hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.
- 1.4 Changes to Class Rules:

None

Class rule amendment of Rule 42 "free pumping" will apply at wind strength over 10knots and only on flying of the O Flag or recognised substitute

2.0 Advertising

The Organising Authority may require all participating boats to display the event sponsor's advertising in accordance with ISAF, Regulation 20.3 (d) (i).

3.0 Eligibility and Entry

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Finn Class that comply with the class rules and sailors of all ages.

- 3.2 Entries will be accepted on the 15 July 2022 up until 0930hrs Entry fee is \$100.00
- To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority.
- 3.4 All boats may be measured for compliance with the International Finn Class Rules.

4.0 Format of Racing

4.1 a total of 9 races, with a maximum of 3 races in a given day

5.0 Schedule of Events

5.3 Briefing:

Briefing will take place on Friday 15 July at 1030 hours at WYC.

5.4 Racing Schedule:

The scheduled time of the warning signal for Race 1 will be no earlier than 10.45am Friday 15 July 2022

No race shall start after 1445 hours on Sunday 17 July 2022

6.0 Sailing Instructions

6.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available on completion of registration

7.0 Racing Area

7.1 The races will be held on the waters off the Waiuku Yacht Club.

8.0 Courses to be Sailed

The course will be a windward/leeward course with a mark 1 offset and mark 2 gate, or a triangle and windward/leeward course.

9.0 Scoring

- 9.2 5 races will be required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.3 When fewer than 6 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 9.4 If 6 races are completed a boat's worst race score will be discarded

10.0 Alternative Penalties

Appendix P may apply.

1st Master (40yrs + on July 15 2022)

- 1st Grand Master (50yrs 59yrs)
- 1st Great Grand Masters (60yrs+)
- 1st Legend (70yrs plus)
