



Hartley 16 National Regatta Waiuku Yacht Club (9) 10 - 12 February 2024 SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SSI)

The Organising Authority is Waiuku Yacht Club (WYC), Sandspit Road, Waiuku.

This sheet and Addendum A are supplements to Appendix S of the Racing Rules of Sailing.

Note: The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the SSI means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification. The notation [NP] in a rule in the SSI means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

NOTICES TO COMPETITORS (SI 2)

SSI 1 The race office is located at the WYC Clubrooms. The official notice board is located inside the WYC clubrooms.

CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SI 3)

SSI 2 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 09:00 on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 18:00 on the day before it will take effect. This changes SI 3.1.

SIGNALS MADE ASHORE (SI 4)

SSI 3 Signals ashore will be displayed on the flagstaff located in front of WYC.

SSI 4 When flag AP is displayed ashore '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in Race Signals AP.

SSI 5 On Monday 12th February, no warning signal will be made after 15:00.

SSI 6 One extra race per day may be sailed, provided that no class becomes more than one race ahead of schedule and the change is made according to SSI 2.

COURSES (SI 7)

SSI 7 The courses to be sailed, in the order which the marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left, are shown in Addendum A.

MARKS (SI 8)

SSI 8 The description of the marks is below the course diagrams shown in Addendum A.

THE START (SI 9)

SSI 9 To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with one sound at least five minutes before a warning signal is made.

SSI 10 A boat starting later than five minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1 and A5.2.

CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE (SI 10)

SSI 11 When Mark 1 has been replaced, Mark 1a is no longer a mark of the course. It will be removed as soon as practicable.

THE FINISH (SI 11)

SSI 12 The race committee may award a finishing score to a boat that is still racing by displaying to her from a committee vessel (which may be in motion) flag W with one sound signal. A boat so notified is no longer required to sail the course (changing rule 28), shall stop racing and shall return to the starting area, or return ashore if there is no more racing. A finishing score under this SSI will be the score she would have received had she sailed the course and finished within any time limit, without gaining or losing any place. However, when two or more boats that are overlapped are notified, they will be scored as if they were tied. This changes SI 11.1.

TIME LIMITS (SI 12)

Class	Target Time for first finisher	Race Time Limit
Hartley 16	40mins	80mins

There is no prescribed time limit for the first boat to pass Mark 1.

SSI 13 Failure to meet the Target Time will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).

PENALTY SYSTEM

SSI 14 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

CHECK OUT AND CHECK IN

SSI 15 All boats shall comply with the following check out and check in procedure:

- a. Competitors shall individually check out before racing each day by personally signing the check out sheets located at WYC.
- b. Competitors shall individually check in immediately on returning to shore after racing each day, by personally signing the check in sheets located at WYC.
- c. A boat that retires from a race or returns to the launching area before she finished shall notify the race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.

REPLACEMENT OF CREW OR EQUIPMENT

SSI 16 [DP] Substitution of competitors is not allowed without prior written approval of the Race Committee.

SSI 17 [DP] Substitution of damaged or lost equipment is not allowed unless authorized in writing by the Race Committee. Requests for substitution shall be made to the committee at the first reasonable opportunity, which may be after the race.

EQUIPMENT AND MEASUREMENT CHECKS

SSI 18 A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the class rules, notice of race and sailing instructions.

SSI 19 [DP] When instructed by a race official on the water, a boat shall proceed to a designated area for inspection.

COMMUNICATIONS

SSI 20 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

OFFICIAL VESSELS

SSI 21 Official vessels will be identified at Briefing.

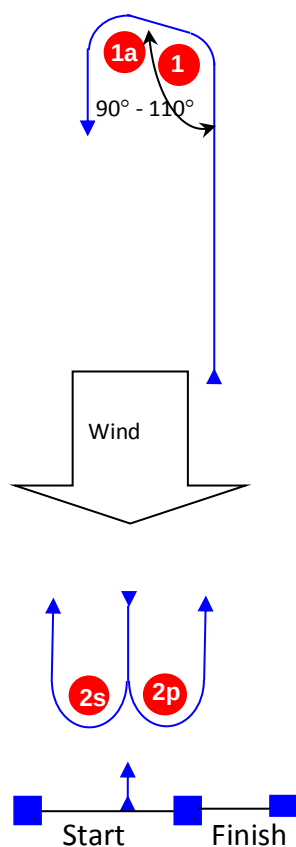
PRIZES

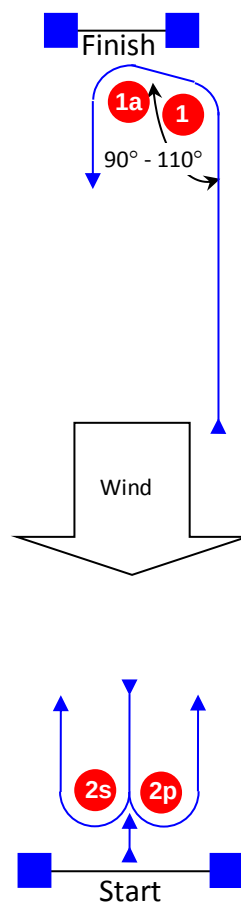
