Notice of Race

1.0 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 The Racing Rules will be changed in accordance with rule 86 as follows:
For protests where only a Rule of Part 2 is alleged to have been broken an Arbitration Hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.
- 1.4 Changes to Class Rules: None.

2.0 Advertising

The Organising Authority may require all participating boats to display the event sponsor's advertising in accordance with ISAF, Regulation 20.3 (d) (i).

3.0 Eligibility and Entry

The regatta is open to all boats of the International OK Dinghy Class that comply with the class rules.

Entries will be accepted up until 11:00am on Saturday 8th November. The entry fee is \$80.00. Please pay into the WYC bank account (02 0476 0017633 00) with your sail number in the reference field, or bring cash. No EFTPOS is available.

4.0 Format of Racing

Our objective is to run “quick fire” back to back races, each of approximately 15 to 20 minutes duration, with minimal wait time between races.

5.0 Schedule of Events

5.1 Briefing:

Briefing will take place at 11:00am on Saturday 8th November at WYC.

5.2 Racing Schedule:

The scheduled time of the warning signal for Race 1 will be no earlier than 11.30am on Saturday 8th November, and no earlier than 12.00pm on Sunday 9th November. No race shall start after 3:30pm on Sunday 9th November.

6.0 Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available at briefing.

7.0 Racing Area

The races will be held on the waters off the WYC.

8.0 Courses to be Sailed

The course will be windward/leeward with a mark 1 offset and a downwind finish.

9.0 Scoring

9.1 1 race will be required to be completed to constitute a series.

9.2 When fewer than 6 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

9.3 If 6 or more races are completed a boat's worst race score will be discarded.

10.0 Penalty System

RRS rule 44.1 shall be changed so that “Two-Turns Penalty” becomes “270 degree penalty”. There is no penalty for touching a mark.

11.0 Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall, and to 1st on Handicap.

12.0 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
